Founded in 2024, Positive Aviation designs and develops the FF72, a new-generation European amphibious aircraft (scooper and water bomber) intended to succeed the Canadair. By converting existing ATR 72 aircraft, the FF72 significantly reduces production and sales costs, while offering optimal operational performance and availability for wildfire suppression missions.

This funding will enable the Toulouse-based company to continue flight testing and certification of the FF72, with a first flight scheduled for summer 2026, and to strengthen its industrial and capital base in France.
