Chammas & Marcheteau advises Supernova Invest on Stellaria's €23 million fundraising (Nuclear/Energy/Deeptech)

Chammas & Marcheteau advised Supernova Invest, co-lead investor alongside US-based At One Ventures, on Stellaria's €23 million fundraising, joined by historical investors CEA Investissement, Technip Energies and Schneider Electric.

Founded in 2023, Stellaria is developing a fourth-generation molten salt nuclear reactor (MSR – Molten Salt Reactor) technology.

This new financing will enable Stellaria to complete preparatory laboratory experiments, double its workforce, and move forward in identifying a site for its 10MW prototype reactor (approximately one-twentieth the size of the final version).
